Senior Finals

Wednesday, June 15th Senior Finals in Periods 5 and 6. Seniors are required to attend ALL periods.
Thursday, June 16th Senior Finals in Periods 3 and 4. Seniors are required to attend 0-4 periods

Graduation Tickets

Tickets will be distributed with all Caps & Gowns on Wednesday, June 1st at lunch in the auditorium. Each student will receive 4 tickets. Each ticket admits 2 guests. Tickets will be collected upon entry to the stadium for graduation. If extra tickets are needed, there will be a limited amount available **after** the senior meeting, Friday, June 17th in the Attendance Office.

Senior Recognition and Graduation Attire

Graduation is considered a traditional and formal occasion. **Any student not complying with the appropriate dress will be sent home!**

The following graduation attire is appropriate:

Males

Ties: **REQUIRED**- conventional, long type
Slacks: Dress style, dark recommended-**NO JEANS!**
Shoes: Dress shoes-**NO TENNIS SHOES, SANDALS**
OR “BEACH” TYPE FLIP-FLOPS
Coat: Optional- under gown
Shirt: **COLLARED** dress shirt
Socks: **MUST** wear socks-dark colored

Females

Shoes: Dressy shoes-low heels recommended. **NO TENNIS SHOES OR “BEACH” TYPE FLIP-FLOPS**
Dress: Dress, skirt or pantsuit – **NO JEANS!**
Sweater: Optional – under gown

Cap & Gown Distribution

When: Wednesday, June 1, 2011 during snack and lunch in the auditorium

CAP & GOWN MUST be kept free of **ANY** external alterations or adornments. NO flowers, leis, or corsages. ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE COMMENCEMENT PROGRAM.

You may not carry **ANYTHING** with you during the commencement ceremony. Please leave all personal items (purses, yearbooks, etc.) at home or with a family member. **CELL PHONES AND / OR IPODS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT THE GRADUATION PRACTICE OR CEREMONY!**

Diploma Distribution

When: Thursday, June 30th Where: Main Office, Reception Area - Time: 8:00 – 11:00 am and 1:00 – 3:00 pm
Diploma distribution will continue throughout the month of July: Monday – Thursday, 8 am – 12 noon, and 1:00 – 4:00 pm. The office is closed on Fridays.

All charges, textbook and library must be cleared BEFORE any diploma will be issued.

Reminders on Prom

Safety is our main concern. Please leave all prescription drugs, eye drops, gum etc. at home. You will be searched by the event's security and these items will be taken away. If you choose to hire a bus or limo the company has very strict rules and laws they must follow.

If anyone in the car, bus, or limo is under the influence, everyone in the whole car, bus, or limo will go home. All parents in that vehicle will be called. Those under the influence in the car, bus, or limo, or caught at any other time during the night: Seniors – 5 day suspension and will not walk at graduation.
Underclassmen – 5 day suspension and suspended from prom the following year.

Pranks/Practical Jokes – participation in any activity that leads to the destruction of school property, including the creation of extreme mess, is *punishable by school discipline, which may include exclusion from school events (prom, etc), restitution, and/or community service*. Criminal consequences may be incurred depending on the level of damage.
