(*note that close contact is defined as being within 6' of the other person for a cumulative amount of time that is 15 mins or more over the course of any 24 hr period. Possible symptoms of COVID-19 in adults include having a measured temp greater than 100.4, feeling feverish (chills, sweating), new cough (different from baseline), shortness of breath, muscle or body aches, diarrhea or vomiting, or new loss of taste or smell.)

In the last 10 days, has your student attended any social gatherings with others outside of your household, outside of those permitted by LACDPH guidelines?

(Fully vaccinated people can attend a small, outdoor gathering with fully vaccinated and unvaccinated people without wearing a mask. They can also have an indoor, informal social gathering where everyone is fully vaccinated, except for guests of one household that does have any not fully vaccinated people (including children) living in it that are at high risk for severe illness or death from COVID-19, without wearing a mask or staying six feet (distancing). Fully vaccinated people should still protect themselves and others by wearing a mask when in indoor public spaces, indoors with unvaccinated people, or attending a crowded, outdoor event. If you are not fully vaccinated, outdoor gatherings of up to 100 people are permitted with masks required, and indoor gatherings are permitted but strongly discouraged for up to 50 people or 50% of the space's capacity, with masks required. Supervised educational settings, outdoor sports conditioning, faith-based services, outdoor protests, and organized gatherings that meet the definition of indoor or outdoor private meetings or live events must be in compliance with LACDPH guidelines. If you attended a social gathering that does not comply with LACDPH guidelines, you must (1) quarantine for 7 days if you have evidence of a negative COVID-19 viral PCR test result from a specimen collected 3-5 days after the gathering or (2) quarantine for 10 days if you were not tested after the gathering.)

Is your student subject to travel quarantine requirements due to out of state travel in the last 7-10 days?

If your student is not fully vaccinated, they must (1) quarantine for 7 days if they have evidence of a negative COVID-19 viral PCR test result from a specimen collected 3-5 days after their arrival in California or (2) quarantine for 10 days if they were not tested after their arrival in California. If they were fully vaccinated (2 or more weeks past their single Johnson & Johnson vaccination shot or their second Pfizer or Moderna vaccination shot) before their travel, your student does not need to quarantine.
