The staff members of Mira Costa High School would like to welcome you back for another great school year! Please be sure to read this document and all school communication as they are important to a smooth start to school.

All students must attend registration at any time during their assigned time below or on the make-up registration dates. At registration students will take school photos (come camera ready!), get student ID cards, pick up textbooks, and any PE clothes or items ordered from the Student Store.

What can *students* do to help?

Student class schedules will be visible in Aeries the first day of registration. They should then log-in to Aeries the morning of the first day of school to ensure they are attending the most up-to-date schedule. Should a schedule change be necessary, students will have the opportunity to submit a Schedule Change Request Google Form. This link will be emailed to all students at their mbusdapps.org email account the first day of registration.

What can *parents* do to help?

Be aware that the counselors will not be able to make schedule changes on the phone or through email as they are going through every student's schedule in the days leading up to day one of school. Parents can make sure their student submits a Schedule Change Request Google Form, if needed.

Prior to registration, it is MANDATORY that parents complete the online *Aeries Parent Data Confirmation Process*. Please refer to the email sent from MCHS in July/August with details regarding this process. **Parents will need to print out and sign the registration verification form, the MBUSD Behavior Intervention and Discipline Matrix Notification Acknowledgement form, and the MBUSD Safe Storage of Firearms Advisory Acknowledgement form (please write student name and grade level on form) found under the "Documents" tab in the Parent Aeries portal, and send the printout with their student on their registration day. Students will not be able to register without this form.**

New students who have moved to the District over the summer, please visit the Mira Costa website at www.miracostahigh.org. Under "News and Announcements", click on the enrollment icon. Follow directions found in the last column. Bring complete enrollment packets to Mira Costa and place them in the drop box near the front entrance to the main office, beginning August 4th. New students/parents will be contacted by a counselor the second week of August to schedule classes. We look forward to meeting you!
